CORRESPONDENCE

The following correspondence all came from the Estate of Robert L Bridges, 1910-?. He went to sea at the age of 12 on the SS Mongolia, an American ship that transported U.S. troops to France during WW I. His idol was John Paul Jones, who became a Captain at the age of 20. At age 15 Bridges joined the U.S. Merchant Marines and by the age of 20 he became Captain of his own boat, a 1,000 ton tramp. During WW II he was Captain of a merchant ship. Following the war he became interested in accumulating German military autographs and information. He would mail a typed letter to various high ranking German officers. He always made a copy and would attach it to the reply. Most of the replies are in German, some are in English, some are typed, some are written, some are postcards and some are Christmas cards.
