TWO UNUSUAL LETTERS: 1840 Letter from Underwood, Bald, Spencer and Huffy, bank note printers and engravers, to D.W. Darlington, President of the Bank of Chester County in West Chester, PA, soliciting the bank's permission to ready plates for the printing of \$1, \$2 and \$3 notes or other denominations and enclosing a few cancelled notes to "present the style of our work". Included are the letter, the envelope and the cancelled bank note proofs sent with the letter. There are five notes: 2 types of \$1 note, \$3 note, \$5 note and a \$10 note. 1847 Letter from Underwood, Bald, Spencer and Huffy, bank note printers and engravers, requesting payment of \$257 for work done.
