Pistol – U.S. Harpers Ferry Model 1805, dated 1807 flintlock pistol, side is stamped U.S. with eagle Harpers Ferry 1807, barrel has eagle head with the letter “P” under eagle head proof mark, U.S. proof mark and 1473 , missing ram rod. This gun came with letter from a family member dated 1958 giving its history, originally owned by John Mabbeth Mott, born April 26 th 1807, died October 9 th 1864.
